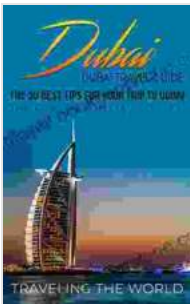

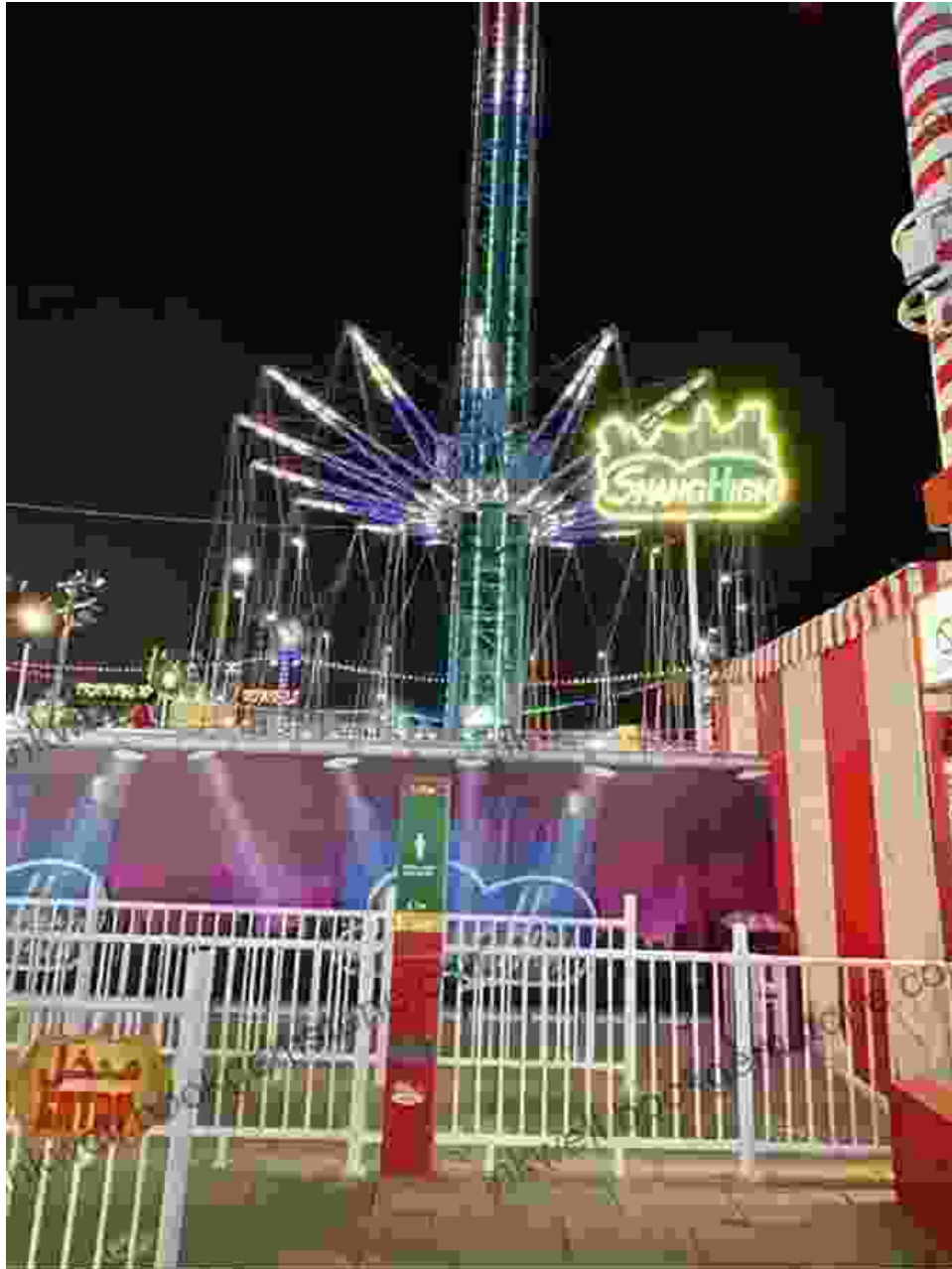
5. Visit the Dubai Frame

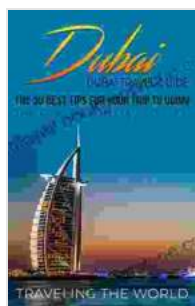

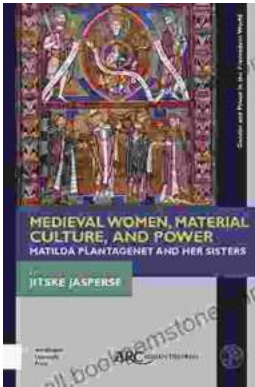
